

## RED OAK (*Quercus rubra*)

43.5139 N, 72.1349 W

This red oak with a circumference of nearly 9 feet and a diameter at breast height of 32 inches is the largest oak in the park. We don't know the age of this tree, but as a rule of thumb an oak with a diameter of 2 feet will be about 100 years old. Further, because their growth rate slows as they age, this tree could well be 150-200 years old. Red Oaks are known to live up to 500 years.
