ADMINISTRATIVE

Approval of Minutes for the October 19, 2015 Meeting

Brookside Park

Trail work

Since Woods was absent, there was no update on the status of the trails.

Bridge Discussion

Kaszeta discussed his work on the footers for the bridge. Considerable progress has been made to create the forms needed for the footers. It is expected that the east side pad will require significantly more concrete than the west pad. The rebar work is expected to be completed soon. Planning wise it is expected that the 38 foot I-beams will be delivered at the end of April or early

May. Thereafter the work will get underway to install the beams on the footers in late May or early June. The decking will be recycled Trex which has been cut to length by Wood.
