Community Power Plan: Warren Kimball presented the committee with information from a meeting he attended of the Community Power Plan of the Clean Energy NH group. Essentially it is a power purchase agreement that the town would enter into for all town residents. The Clean Energy group purchases their power from renewable power generation, and promises lower prices for electricity through a 20-year agreement.

During the discussions of this offer the committee had many questions. It was decided that we should invite Henry Herndon to one of our meetings for clarification of the agreement or possible town meeting to speak to a wider group. Jenna will contact Henry.
