The regular meeting of the Grantham Energy Committee was called to order at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 5, 2018 by co-chair Chenevert.

Approval of February Minutes: Burgard moved to approve the February minutes and Bresnick seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous to approve the minutes.

Correspondence: The Committee discussed the links from Rebecca Ohler regarding an EV Charger Station. Possible locations were identified.

Old Business:

Committee members: The Committee said goodbye to Kristina Burgard, who is not renewing her place on the Committee. Susan Goodwin will be joining the Committee next month.

Town Meeting: The quote and contract regarding the Town Solar Project as proposed by the Committee has been removed from the Town Meeting agenda. The Committee wondered what the position of the Selectman was regarding renewable energy given the postponement of the solar project. The question of what the Town expects from the Energy Committee was raised.

New Business:

Town Wide Solar Tour: The Committee discussed a proposed Town Wide Solar Open House/Tour. The date should be after school gets out and after black fly season. The homeowners would need to agree and the vendors contacted. A pamphlet for the tour would be helpful. It was decided June 23, 2018 would suit.

Net Zero Building: The Committee decided to hold a forum on Smart Building Construction on September 11, 2018. Details will be discussed at upcoming meetings.
