The regular meeting of the Grantham Energy Committee was called to order at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 2, 2017 by co-chair Chenevert.

Approval of September Minutes: Martineau moved to approve the September minutes and Burgard seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous to approve the minutes.

Old Business:

EV Charging stations: Chenevert informed the Committee that no response has come from Eversource or Upper Valley Lake Sunapee Regional Planning Commission regarding electric vehicle charging stations in Grantham. Bresnick had spoken with the Town Manager of Norwich, VT who had received a state grant to cover the town costs of their new charging station. Discussion about possible locations, and possible sponsorships for the Charging station followed.

Committee member status: Burgard reminded the Committee she would not be re-enlisting as a volunteer member of the Energy Committee this spring. Chenevert suggested some residents who have expressed an interest in being on the GEC.
