Items accepted for Recycling (sorted into the following categories):

Paper:

Comingled: Newsprint, glossy inserts, magazines, junk mail, envelopes, file folders, books (hardcovers removed), and cardboard items such as cereal boxes, egg cartons, etc.

Not Permitted: Wrapping paper, tissue paper, waxed coated cartons, and beer containers. Why are beer containers not permitted? Beer containers are coated with a chemical that cannot be broken down through the normal recycling process. If our paper loads are contaminated with this material, the whole load could be rejected. We appreciate your help and understanding with this.

Plastic:

All plastics #0 – 7. Must be rinsed/cleaned. Caps must be removed, and then they are recycled in this category.

Not Permitted: Plastics labeled “Other,” plant containers, plastic bags, plastics containing motor/equipment oil, plastic wrap, bubble wrap, coat hangers, large plastic items such as 5-gallon water jugs, and cat litter buckets.

Aluminum:

All aluminum, (including aluminum aerosol cans. Aluminum containers must be emptied and rinsed; aerosol cans must be emptied.

Note: Aluminum will not allow a magnet to stick to it. If a magnet sticks to it, it is tin or steel and recycled in that category.

Tin/Steel:

All tin/steel, including tin aerosol cans. Tin containers must be emptied and rinsed. Aerosol cans must be emptied.

Note: Tin/steel will allow a magnet to stick to it. If a magnet does not stick, it goes into aluminum.

Glass:

Bottles and food jars only. Lids are typically tin and can be recycled in that category.

Not Permitted: Dishware, cups, windows, mirrors, etc.

Corrugated Cardboard:

Corrugated cardboard. It must be clean and not contaminated with grease or other food particles.

Not Permitted: Beer containers; see above.

Please note: If you are unsure if something is recyclable at our facility, please check with an attendant.
