The Energy Committee Meeting was called to order by Jenna Chenevert.

Emily Owens facilitated the virtual meeting.

The first item of business was a virtual presentation by John Gage from carboncashback.org. John explained with the use of slides, that the aim of this piece of legislation is to reduce carbon emission. The bi-partisan legislation would charge carbon producers and users for the carbon they are using and redistribute the funds to all citizens.

The first step for the town of Grantham would be to prepare a warrant article and then petition for it to be placed on the agenda for the March annual Town Meeting. Twenty five signatures are required to have this placed on the agenda. Resident Ebba McCart will be contacted to see if this is a program she has been working on. Emily Owens will get back to the committee with the date the petition must be completed.

Minutes from the August 31, 2020 were approved. Motion made by Don Fitzpatrick and second from Andy Gelston.

The committee agreed that a notice of the existing renewable resource incentives which will expire should be placed in the Grantham newsletter.
